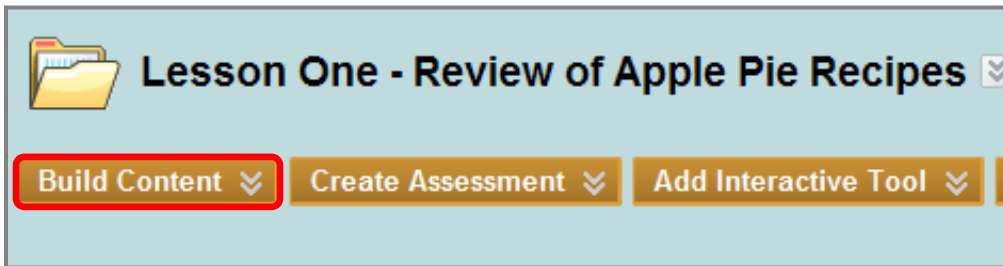


Adding a SlideShare Presentation

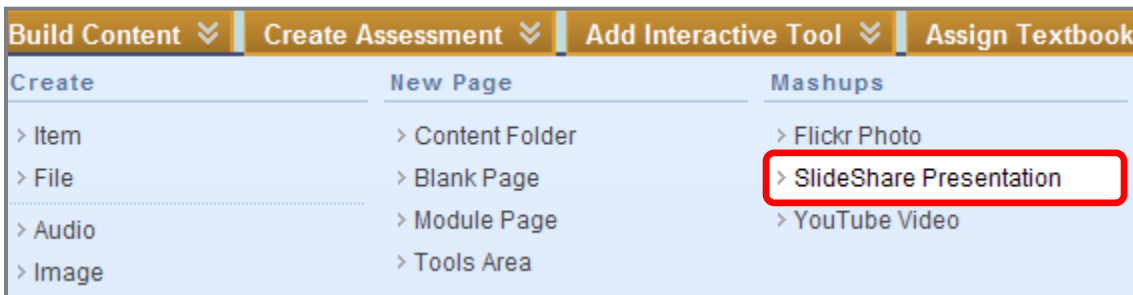
A **SlideShare Presentation** is a presentation, video, or document that has been shared publicly at SlideShare.net. In Blackboard 9.1, **SlideShare Presentations** are categorized as Mashups. They are easy to add and increase the interactivity in a lesson.

Follow these step-by-step instructions to add a **SlideShare Presentation**:

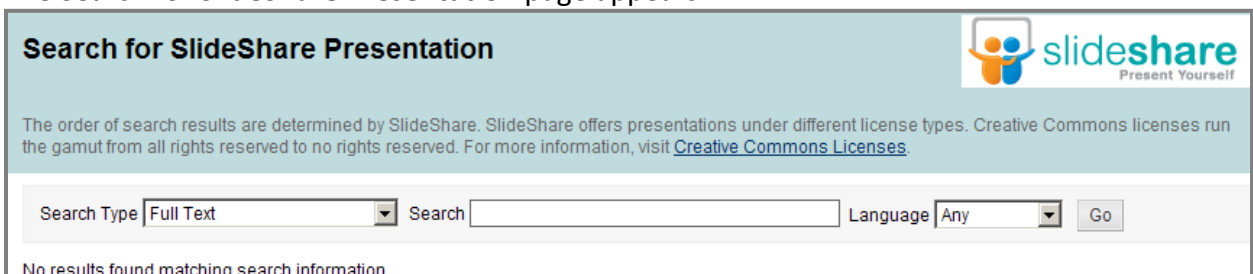
1. Navigate to a content area by clicking one of the Course Menu buttons. In this case let's use the "Lessons" button, *Lesson One* folder.
2. Hover over *Build Content*.



3. Click on *SlideShare Presentation*.

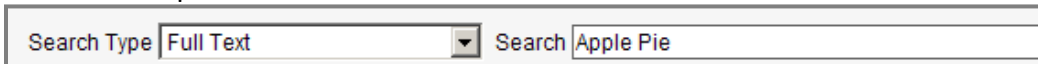


4. The Search for **SlideShare Presentation** page appears.

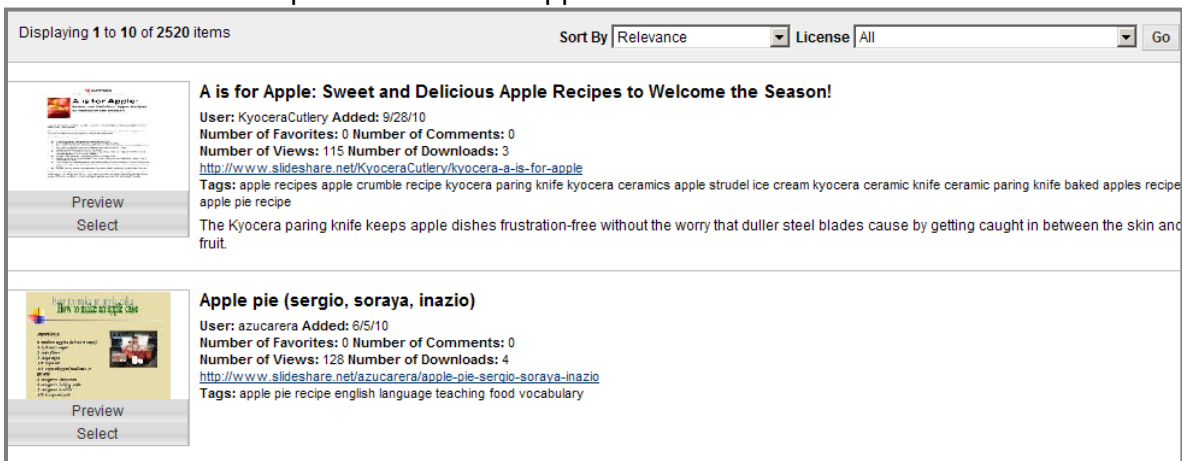


5. Instructors can search for presentations using a:
 - a. Full Text search
 - b. A Tags only search, or
 - c. A URL search.

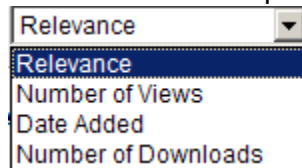
6. Enter Search parameters in the Search field.



7. A sortable list of slide presentations will appear.



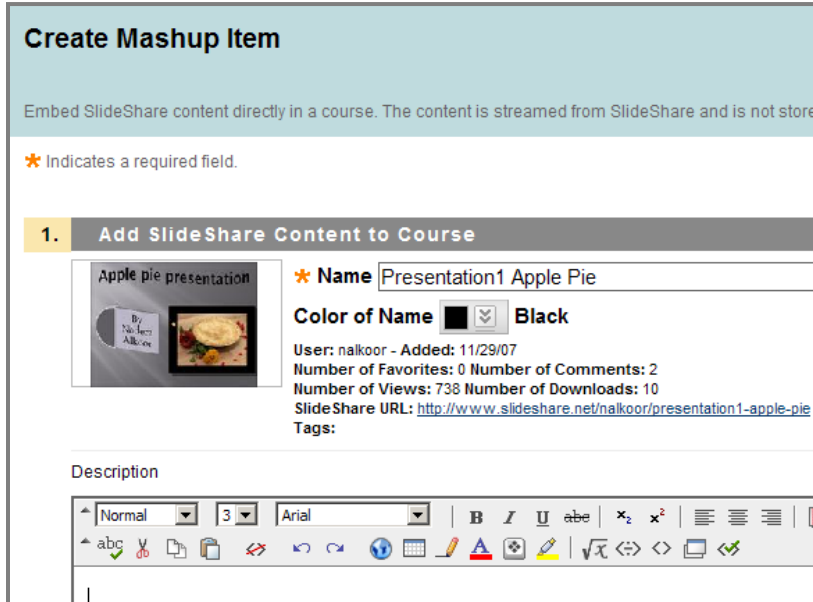
8. Instructors can sort presentations by the following criteria.




9. Click *Preview* to view the presentation, document, or video in a separate window.



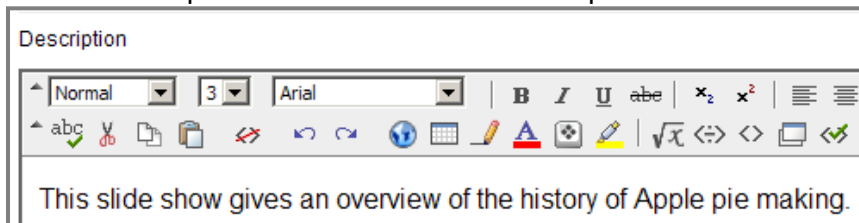
10. Click *Select* to place the slide show in the course site. The Create Mashup Item page opens.



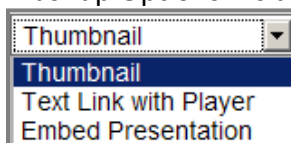
11. Enter a Name for the video in the Name Field.



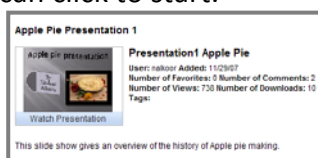
12. Enter a Description of the video in the Description textbox.



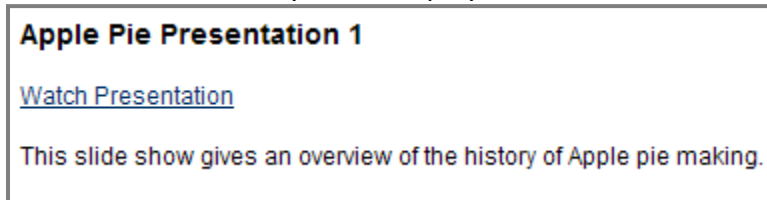
13. Mashup Options include display options for a SlideShare.



a. Display as a Thumbnail will appear as a small picture of the presentation, which the user can click to start.



- b. The Text Link with Player will display as text.



- c. The Embed Presentation choice will display a presentation viewer in the center frame of Blackboard.



14. Instructors have the option to Show the SlideShare URL and to Show SlideShare Information.

15. Attach any files the students may need to the **SlideShare Presentation** by clicking *Browse My Computer*.

Attach a file from a local drive, Course Files, or the Content Collection. All attached files are saved in Course Files. Click **Do Not Attach** to remove the attachment. The file itself is not deleted.

16. Select *Yes* to make the **Item** visible to students.

17. You may choose to select *Date and Time Restrictions*.

Enter dates as mm/dd/yyyy. Time may be entered in any increment.

Enter dates as mm/dd/yyyy. Time may be entered in any increment.

18. Click the *Submit* button.



19. Blackboard displays a Success message at the top of the screen.



20. The **SlideShare Presentation** now appears in the content area.
